3-DAY NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION

RWE Solar Development, LLC (“Applicant”) is proposing to construct a major electric generating facility under Article VIII of the New York State Public Service Law (“Article VIII”). This notice announces that on or after July 20, 2026, Applicant will file an Application pursuant to Article VIII and its implementing regulations (the “Article VIII Process”) under ORES DMM Matter No. 24-03035. The Article VIII Process has been implemented by rules enacted by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (“ORES”) and establishes a review process with uniform standards and conditions for all renewable energy projects. The uniform standards and conditions are available at Chapter XI, Title 16 of NYCRR Part 1101 and <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-regulatory-documents>.

The Town Line Solar and Storage Project is a utility scale solar photovoltaic energy generation facility with a battery storage system proposed to be located in the Towns of Thompson and Forestburgh, Sullivan County, New York (the “Facility”).

The Facility is a zero-emission solar energy facility that will assist the State in meeting the goals of the Climate Leadership and Protection Act and State Energy Plan, which includes obtaining 70% of energy generation from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive impacts of the Facility include diversification of energy supplies, new employment opportunities (both temporary construction and full-time employment), increased revenues to the Towns of Thompson and Forestburgh, Sullivan County, and School Districts, payments to participating landowners, support of the local hospitality industry, and purchase of local supplies and goods. In addition, the Applicant has attempted to avoid and minimize impacts associated with the Facility, for example, by limiting impacts to cultural resources and wetlands to the maximum extent practicable. The Applicant will submit an Application that includes extensive studies evaluating the potential impacts associated with the Facility and identified methods which have been agreed to be implemented to avoid, minimize and mitigate potential impacts. This notice is being provided in accordance with 16 NYCRR 1100-1.6(c) and is being published at least three (3) days prior to the filing of the Application.

Pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1100-5, Town Line will submit with the Application \$1,000 dollars for each MW of capacity for local agencies and potential intervenors, which, for this project totals \$200,000. Any local agency or potential community intervenor can submit a request to the Office for funding within thirty (30) days of the date of the application filing. Seventy-five percent of the local agency account funds shall be reserved for local agencies.
